Sub: Regarding Reimbursement of payment for Individuals case.

Sir,

With reference to the meeting held with DHS on 10th Jan 2010 with the representatives of the association regarding the difficulties faced by beneficiaries especially the retired teachers, it is informed that :

1. For smooth implementation of the provision of cashless treatment at empanelled hospitals, a centralised system for payment to empanelled hospitals for cashless treatment of pensioners by the hospitals has been started w.e.f 15th Dec 2009 through DDHS(HQ). However, till such time the decision for centralized medical reimbursements for individual pensioner beneficiaries is notified, ***the medical reimbursement for bills of the individual pensioner beneficiaries shall continue to be made from respective office/schools.***
2. The process for appointing the local chemists for select Delhi Govt. Dispensaries for supply of medicines has been initiated and tender is likely to be finalized by March 2010, with the mechanism likely to be operational by end March 2010/April 2010 thus obviating any need for individual reimbursements on account of purchase of medicines. Thereafter, the process for instituting a centralized mechanism for payments to individual pensioners is likely to be initiated in April 2010.
3. Regarding the issue of making the scheme openended on lines of CGHS for pensioners not members of scheme, the issue is under active consideration of Government.
