Sir,

Please refer to above correspondence on the subject cited above, it is requested to intimate that whether the all provisions of the scheme are being implemented in your hospital/Distt and if not the reason thereof and the action taken report particularly on following provisions of the DGEHS:

1. All medicines, surgical or non surgical items (including implants, consumable and non consumable etc.) required during the course of medical treatment (outdoor or indoor) for DGEHS beneficiary shall be provided by the hospital/dispensary without any charge.
2. In case of chronic illnesses requiring prolonged treatment, the medicines may be dispensed for one month at a time. However, in case of Senior Citizen beneficiaries with chronic conditions, requiring prolonged treatment, the same may be dispensed up to three months on the decision of the AMA at the attached Dispensary/Hospital.
3. In case prescribed medicines for the pensioner beneficiary are not available at the attached dispensary through the normal indent system under DHS, the dispensary shall get the same from nearest linked Delhi Government Hospital, till the new system for supply of medicines through local chemists is in place. For this purpose, an indent on regular basis will be sent to the linked hospital and the same shall be dispensed to the beneficiaries by the dispensary. The link hospital shall procure and supply the same to the dispensary.
4. Separate queue/counter for registration/ dispensing medicines for beneficiaries shall be provided in the hospitals. Preference should be given to DGEHS beneficiaries at the consultation room /investigations/sample collection.
5. A Nodal Officer shall be designated to look after the work of DGEHS in the hospital/district. All hospitals/ districts/dispensaries shall maintain records of DGEHS beneficiaries attached to them, referrals and other information pertaining to DGEHS. The names of these nodal officers with telephone numbers may be communicated to DGEHS cell by the CDMOs/Medical Superintendents.

The requisite action taken report is immediately required to appraise the latest position on above provisions to higher authorities at the earliest.
