4. Only challenges filed through the e-challenge module will be accepted. No other mode of challenge including letters will be entertained.
5. Challenges against answer keys for the said exam can be filed upto 07/11/2017 after which no challenge will be accepted.

Instruction to candidates of post code 16/17 for filling up e- Challenge.

- E-Challenge may be filed by the candidate after logging into the OARS account.
- Since the series pattern of the question papers have not been revealed, candidates are required to file challenges with reference to a particular booklet called the "Master Booklet", a copy of which is being provided as PDF. The Master booklet will appear as series "A" in the e-Challenge module.
- The candidate should select those questions which are intended to be challenged and then ascertain their serial numbers in the Master booklet. The e-Challenge is to be filed as per the number of booklet in the Master Booklet.

e.g.: The candidate wants to challenge a particular question which appears at S. No. 86 in the question booklet given to him during the exam. He should locate the same question in the Master booklet. If the question appears at S. No. 95 in the master booklet, the candidate should file his e-Challenge by selecting Series A, Question No. 95 in the e-Challenge Module.
