WALK-IN-INTERVIEW FOR THE POST OF SENIOR RESIDENTS, ON ADHOC BASIS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MEDICINE, ORTHOPEDICS AND OPHTHALMOLOGY, AND JR. RESIDENTS (MBBS), ON ADHOC BASIS) ON 02.07.2018

The Central Jail Hospital, Tihar, Prison Department, GNCT of Delhi will hold a Walk-In-Interview for filling up the vacant posts of Sr. Residents in the Department of MEDICINE, ORTHOPEDICS and OPHTHALMOLOGY, purely on adhoc basis, and Jr. Residents (MBBS), on adhoc basis on 02.07.2018 at Tihar. Only those candidates may appear for the interview who fulfill the eligibility criteria as per Residency Scheme of the GOI and the qualification/eligibility criteria as given below:-

The details regarding educational qualification, emoluments, age limit, terms and conditions etc, in r/o Sr. Residents and Jr. Residents [MBBS and Dental] are as under:-

Qualification for Sr. Residents:- MBBS Degree from a recognized University/Institution with P.G Degree/Diploma/DNB in respective speciality and candidate must not have completed 03 years Senior Residency in any recognized institution including regular and adhoc period. In the event of non-availability of PG degree/diploma holder, candidate having MBBS degree with minimum 02 years work experience in Govt. Hospital [out of which at least one year should be in the speciality concerned] may be considered. Registration of PG/Diploma/DNB in speciality with **Delhi Medical Council is compulsory**

QUALIFICATION FOR JR. RESIDENTS (MBBS):-

MBBS from recognized university/institution with internship completion certificate. **Registration with Delhi Medical Council is compulsory. Candidates who have completed internship earlier than 02 years on the date of interview shall not be eligible. However, they may apply under relax norms of GOI's residency scheme.**

TENURE OF SR. RESIDENTS & JR. RESIDENTS (MBBS)

Initially appointed for a period of 89 days OR till regular appointment is made by the Government under any scheme or proposal, whichever is earlier. In case of no regular appointment is made by the government, the tenure can be further extended for a further period of 89 days OR till regular appointment is made by the Government under any scheme or proposal, whichever is earlier.

EMOLUMENTS:

For Sr. Residents:- As per 7th CPC pay matrix level 11, Pay Rs. 67700 plus allowances as admissible under the rules.

For Jr. Residents (MBBS & Dental):- As per 7th CPC pay matrix level 10, Pay Rs. 56100 plus allowances as admissible under the rules.

AGE LIMIT:

For Sr. Residents:- 40 years , 03 years relaxable for OBC candidates [**belonging to Delhi only**] on the date of interview.

For Jr. Residents:- 30 years for General, 05 years relaxable for SC/ST and 03 years for OBC candidates [**belonging to Delhi only**] on the date of interview.

Further in case of non-availability of candidates, as per the relevant scheme mentioned above, candidates may be considered in terms of the relaxation of provision as per circular No. F.121/26/2010/H&FW/1996/2045 Dated 10.06.2011, issued by H&FW Department, GNCT of Delhi with the following relaxation.

For Sr. Residents:-

1. In case of non-availability of fresh candidates for the post of Sr. Residents, Candidates who have completed 03 years of Residency as Senior Residents may be allowed to appear in the interview.
2. Separate merit list for a fresh candidates and for other i.e. those who have already completed three years of Senior Residency would be prepared.
3. Firstly, the list containing the name of fresh candidates would be exhausted for appointment as Sr. Resident and the second list would be used only after that. There would be no extension for any senior resident beyond one year appointed under above mentioned relaxed provisions.

For Jr. Residents

1. Upper age limit for eligibility under relaxation will be 40 years.
2. Post Graduate doctors who are interested to serve as Junior Residents will be Allowed to join as Junior Resident, if fresh graduate are not available.
3. Junior Residents who have completed one year of Junior Residency may be allowed to again appear for interview for selection and will be offered residency only if no fresh Junior Residents are available. There would be no extension for any junior resident beyond one year appointed under this relaxed provisions.

Other General Conditions/Requirements:

1. The posts will be filled up in phases as per availability of vacancies and as per need of the department. The number of vacancies as shown above may subject to change.
2. Appointment shall be subject to medical fitness and verification of educational certificates.
3. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the interview.
4. In case of non availability of SC,ST and OBC candidates for SR and JR, the posts shall
be filled for 89 days on adhoc basis from General Category Candidates and vice versa.
5. Panel of wait listed candidates will be prepared for filling the post of SR/JR for vacancies arising in future. The Panel shall be valid for 06 months or till fresh selection process is carried out, whichever is earlier.
