OFFICE ORDER

Subject:- Regarding facilities to be provided to Accredited Journalists.

It has been brought into the notice of undersigned that Accredited Journalists are not provided due facilities in Hospitals / Dispensaries. As per provisions of the Delhi Press Reporters Medical Aid Rules 1995 the Accredited Journalists are entitled to the following facilities

1. A press Reporter and the members of his family is entitled to the same treatment to which a Group "A" (Class - I) Gazetted Government Officer is entitled.
2. The Press Reporters is entitled to free medicines as are available in the Hospitals / Dispensaries and is also be entitled to free check up, including all tests like X-Ray, E.C.G., Urine etc.
3. The Press Reporter is also entitled to be admitted to the same type of accommodation as is provided to Group 'A' (Class - I) Gazetted in hospitals.
4. Separate queue / counter should be available in hospitals / dispensaries for registration and consultations for Accredited Journalists. Similar arrangement should also be available at counters for dispensing of drugs and sample collection.
