PUBLIC NOTICE / CIRCULAR

ONLINE COOPERATIVE QUIZ COMPETITION – 2026

The Office of the Registrar Cooperative Societies, Government of NCT of Delhi, is organizing an Online Cooperative Quiz Competition during Cooperative Week 2026 (29 June 2026 to 06 July 2026) with the objective of promoting awareness about the Cooperative Movement, Cooperative Principles and Cooperative Laws among citizens of Delhi.

Eligibility

The competition is open to citizens ordinarily residing in the National Capital Territory of Delhi.

Topics Covered

The Quiz Competition shall cover the following areas:

1. History and Evolution of the Cooperative Movement.
2. Cooperative Values and Principles.
3. Cooperative Governance and Management.
4. Delhi Cooperative Societies Act, 2003.
5. Delhi Cooperative Societies Rules, 2007.
6. Government Initiatives relating to the Cooperative Sector.
7. National and International Cooperative Institutions.
8. Role of Cooperatives in Socio-Economic Development.
9. Other allied topics relating to cooperatives.

Competition Format

- Mode: Online
- Duration: 20 Minutes
- Question Type: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)
- Medium: English/Hindi (if approved)

Selection Process

Participants securing the highest scores in the online quiz shall be shortlisted. The top-ranking participants shall be invited to participate in the Final Round, which shall be conducted physically at a venue to be notified separately.

Certificates of Participation shall be issued to eligible participants completing the online quiz. Certificates of Merit shall be awarded to shortlisted/final-round participants.

Registration

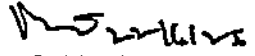

GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE COOPERATIVE QUIZ COMPETITION – 2026
(To be held during Cooperative Week from 29 June 2026 to 06 July 2026)

1. Short Title and Objective

1.1 Short Title

These Guidelines may be called the "Guidelines for Online Cooperative Quiz Competition – 2026".

1.2 Objective

The Online Cooperative Quiz Competition is being organized by the Office of the Registrar Cooperative Societies, Government of NCT of Delhi, during Cooperative Week 2026 with the objective of:

- a) Promoting awareness regarding the Cooperative Movement;
- b) Disseminating knowledge about Cooperative Principles, Values and Governance;
- c) Enhancing understanding of cooperative laws and government initiatives relating to the cooperative sector; and
- d) Encouraging active participation of citizens, students, members of cooperative societies and stakeholders in cooperative activities.

2. Organizing Authority

The Competition shall be organized by the Office of the Registrar Cooperative Societies, Government of NCT of Delhi (RCS Office). The decision of the Registrar Cooperative Societies or any Committee constituted for the purpose of conducting the Competition shall be final and binding on all participants.

3. Eligibility

3.1 Eligible Participants

The Competition shall be open to citizens ordinarily residing in the National Capital Territory of Delhi.

3.2 Ineligible Persons

The following shall not be eligible:

- a) Members of the Quiz Committee, Jury or Evaluation Committee;
- b) Officers/officials directly involved in preparation of question bank and conduct of the competition;
- c) Immediate family members of persons mentioned above;
- d) Persons furnishing false or misleading information during registration.

4. Registration

4.1 Mode of Registration

Registration shall be conducted online through the portal notified by the Department.

4.2 Information Required

Participants shall furnish:

- a) Full Name;
- b) Date of Birth;
- c) Mobile Number;
- d) Email Address;
- e) Residential Address;
- f) Aadhaar Number (last four digits only, if required);
- g) Educational Qualification (optional);
- h) Occupation (optional); and
- i) Any other information considered necessary.

4.3 Verification Documents

Participants may upload any one or more of the following:

- Aadhaar Card;
- Voter Identity Card;
- Driving Licence;
- Passport;
- Educational Institution Identity Card;
- Employment Certificate;
- Utility Bill; or
- Any other document accepted by the Organizing Authority.

4.4 Acceptance of Registration

Registration shall be deemed provisional until verification by the Organizing Authority. The Department reserves the right to reject any application without assigning reasons where eligibility conditions are not fulfilled.

5. Subject Matter

Questions may be drawn from:

5.1 Cooperative Movement

- History of Cooperative Movement in India and abroad;
- Evolution of cooperatives;
- International Cooperative Alliance (ICA).

5.2 Cooperative Principles

- Cooperative Values;
- Seven Cooperative Principles;
- Democratic Member Control;
- Member Economic Participation.

5.3 Cooperative Governance

- Management and governance of cooperative societies;
- Rights and responsibilities of members;
- Functions of Boards and Committees.

5.4 Cooperative Laws

- Delhi Cooperative Societies Act, 2003;
- Delhi Cooperative Societies Rules, 2007;
- Relevant Government notifications and circulars.

5.5 Government Initiatives

- National Cooperative Policy;
- Ministry of Cooperation initiatives;
- Cooperative reforms and digitization.

5.6 Other Allied Topics

- Agricultural cooperatives;
- Housing cooperatives;
- Credit cooperatives;
- Consumer cooperatives;
- Dairy cooperatives;
- International cooperative institutions.

6. Online Quiz

6.1 Format

- Mode: Online
- Duration: 20 Minutes
- Type: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)

6.2 Number of Questions

The Quiz shall ordinarily consist of **50 MCQs** carrying one mark each. The Organizing Authority may vary the number of questions, if required.

6.3 Language

The Quiz may be conducted in English, Hindi or bilingually, as decided by the Department.

6.4 Access

Each participant shall receive login credentials or a unique access link. Login credentials shall be non-transferable.

7. Scoring Pattern

7.1 Marking Scheme

Particular	Marks
Correct Answer	+1
Incorrect Answer	0
Unanswered Question	0

7.2 Negative Marking

There shall ordinarily be no negative marking, unless notified otherwise.

7.3 Ranking

Participants shall be ranked according to total marks obtained.

8. Shortlisting for Final Round

8.1 Number of Candidates

The top 20 participants, or such number as approved by the Competent Authority, shall be shortlisted.

8.2 Verification

Shortlisted participants shall undergo verification of identity and residence before being allowed to participate in the Final Round.

8.3 Failure to Verify

Failure to produce original documents, when required, may result in cancellation of candidature.

9. Final Round

9.1 Mode

The Final Round shall be conducted physically at a venue notified by the Department.

9.2 Format

The format may include:

- Rapid Fire Round;
- Buzzer Round through raising of hand;
- Any other format approved by the Quiz Committee.

9.3 Determination of Winners

Final rankings shall be determined solely on the basis of performance in the Final Round. Scores of the online round shall ordinarily not be carried forward unless otherwise notified.

10. Prizes

The following cash prizes shall be awarded:

The Department reserves the right to modify, enhance or withdraw prizes with approval of the Competent Authority.

11. Certificates

11.1 Participation Certificates

Digital certificates may be issued to participants who successfully complete the online quiz.

11.2 Merit Certificates

Certificates of Merit may be awarded to shortlisted participants and winners.

12. Unfair Means and Disqualification

A participant shall be liable for disqualification if he/she:

- a) Provides false information;
- b) Uses multiple registrations;
- c) Uses another person's identity;
- d) Shares login credentials;
- e) Uses unfair means, bots, automated tools or unauthorized assistance;
- f) Attempts to hack, manipulate or interfere with the online platform;
- g) Indulges in misconduct during the Final Round;
- h) Violates any provision of these Guidelines.

The Organizing Authority may cancel candidature at any stage without prior notice.

13. Quiz Committee

The Registrar Cooperative Societies may constitute a Quiz Committee comprising:

14. Functions of Quiz Committee

The Committee shall:

- a) Approve syllabus and content;
- b) Prepare and moderate question bank;
- c) Supervise conduct of quiz;
- d) Verify shortlisted candidates;
- e) Evaluate complaints and grievances;
- f) Recommend declaration of results;
- g) Perform any other function necessary for successful conduct of the Competition.

15. Confidentiality

The question bank, answer keys and evaluation process shall remain confidential until declaration of results. All officials associated with the Competition shall maintain confidentiality.

16. Declaration of Results

16.1 Online Round

Results of shortlisted candidates shall be published on the Department's website.

16.2 Final Round

Final results shall be declared during the closing ceremony of Cooperative Week or on such date as may be notified.

16.3 Publication

The Department may publish names, photographs and scores of winners on its website and publicity material.

17. Grievance Redressal Mechanism

17.1 Submission of Grievances

Participants may submit grievances through email or online portal within seven (7) days of publication of results.

17.2 Examination

The grievance shall be examined by the Quiz Committee.

17.3 Disposal

The decision of the Quiz Committee, approved by the Registrar Cooperative Societies, shall be final and binding. No representation shall ordinarily be entertained after expiry of the prescribed period.

18. Disclaimer

The Department shall not be responsible for:

- a) Internet connectivity issues;
- b) Power failures;
- c) Device malfunction;
- d) Technical issues arising at the participant's end;
- e) Any loss arising due to incorrect information furnished by participants.

19. Residual Powers

Any matter not specifically covered under these Guidelines shall be decided by the Registrar Cooperative Societies, GNCT of Delhi, whose decision shall be final and binding on all participants.
