Order

This order shall dispose of the proceedings initiated under Section 37(1) of the Delhi Cooperative Societies Act, 2003 vide Show Cause Notice dated 17.04.2026 issued to Shri Ganesh Cooperative (U) T&C Society Ltd.

Brief facts of the case

A complaints dated 26.09.2025 and 28.09.2025 were received through email from Sh. Om Prakash Jindal, President, and Ms. Archana Roy, Treasurer of the Society, alleging that, as per the provisions of the Society's rules and bye-laws, the monthly meetings are required to be presided over by the President. However, it was alleged that the said meetings were being chaired by the Vice-President, Sh. Girish Kumar, without prior intimation to or approval of the President, in contravention of the Society's rules and established procedures. It was further alleged that such actions had created dissatisfaction and mistrust among the members and adversely affected the smooth, transparent, and fair functioning of the Society.

Further complaint dated 14.12.2025 was received from the Vice-President and other members of the Managing Committee alleging that Sh. Om Prakash Jindal, President, and Sh. Raj Pal, Secretary, had deliberately refused to recognize the newly appointed Secretary and failed to comply with the decision taken by the majority of the Managing Committee. It was further alleged that Sh. Raj Pal attempted to undermine the authority of the Managing Committee by convening an emergency meeting and declaring that he would continue to function and conduct meetings as Secretary despite the decision taken by the Committee.

Another complaint dated 11.11.2025 was received from Ms. Ramwati, a member of the Society, alleging financial and administrative irregularities on the part of the President, Sh. Om Prakash Jindal. It was alleged that he had waived loans and interest without the approval of the Executive Committee, sanctioned loans beyond the limits prescribed under the registered bye-laws, and approved loans without maintaining proper records and documentation. The complaint further alleged misuse of Society funds, unauthorized waiver of Society dues including RCS fees and legal expenses, irregular grant of membership to persons allegedly holding membership in more than one cooperative society, and other instances of financial mismanagement. It was also alleged that Sh. Om Prakash Jindal had appointed his close associate, Sh. Raj Pal, as Secretary despite his being a defaulter of the Society and that Sh. Raj Pal was deliberately withholding the release of Fixed Deposit Receipts (FDRs) belonging to members of the Society.

Findings and Observations

During proceeding dated 21.05.2026 and as per resignation received by this office dated 24.02.2026, it is come to notice that that out of the total eleven elected members of the



Managing Committee eight members have resigned. Consequently, the Managing Committee has lost its effective majority and is no longer in a position to function as a duly constituted elected body in accordance with the provisions of the Delhi Cooperative Societies Act, 2003, the Delhi Cooperative Societies Rules, 2007 and the Bye-laws of the Society.

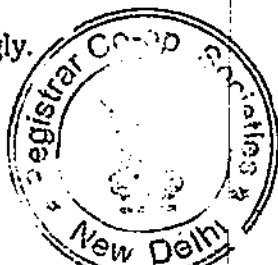
The plea of the Society that two nominated members were co-opted in place of the outgoing members cannot cure the fundamental defect arising from the loss of the elected majority of the Committee. The continued functioning of a Committee which has lost the majority of its elected members is contrary to the principles of democratic management embodied in the cooperative law. Further, co-opted is not allowed in DCS Act and Rules.

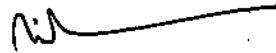
In view of the foregoing facts and circumstances, I am satisfied that the Managing Committee has ceased to function as an effective elected body and has become incapable of managing the affairs of the Society in accordance with law. Although the present proceedings were initiated under Section 37 of the Delhi Cooperative Societies Act, 2003, the subsequent developments brought on record during the proceedings clearly attract the provisions of Section 35(5) of the Act. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 35(5) of the Delhi Cooperative Societies Act, 2003, the present Managing Committee of Shri Ganesh Cooperative (Urban) Thrift & Credit Society Ltd. is hereby superseded with immediate effect.

Further, an Administrator cum R.O Sh. Arun Lal is hereby appointed under Section 35(5) of the Act to manage the affairs of the Society for such period as prescribed under the Act and Rules, or till a newly elected Managing Committee assumes charge, whichever is earlier. The Administrator cum R.O shall take over charge forthwith, ensure smooth functioning of the Society, safeguard records and assets, and initiate steps for conduct of elections in accordance with the provisions of the Act, Rules, and Bye-laws and also resolves the complaints/issues which attracted u/s 37 of DCS Act, 2003.

The Ex-Managing Committee and all Ex-office bearers are directed to hand over complete charge of records, documents, accounts, assets, and all relevant materials of the Society to the Administrator cum R.O receipt of this order. Non-compliance with this direction shall invite appropriate action under the provisions of the Act and Rules.

This order is issued accordingly.
